Entry Form Due by Friday, August 5, 2022

You must be a member of SAA and have paid your \$25 membership dues for 2022 to participate in the show. Due to space limitations, entries are limited to two pieces per member. You may also include an alternate third piece that will be included in the show if space permits. The maximum size of all wall-hung entries must fit within a space 30" wide x 84" (7 feet) high, including frames. If a third piece is submitted, all three must fit within this rectangle. All pieces must be for sale. S.A.M.'s commission is 40% of the sale price.

There will be no entry fee required this year, and there is no requirement for participants to sit the show. No awards will be given this year. Instead of judging, there will be a critique of each piece by artist Barbara Enochian. These will be transcribed and available to participating artists and guests.

CRITIQUE ARTIST: Barbara Enochian

CATEGORIES: Oil, Acrylic, Pastel, Water Media, Mixed Media, Drawing, Printmaking, 3-D Artwork, and Other (e.g. Encaustic, Alcohol Ink) Original art only, completed entirely by the entrant. No reproductions, including Giclee prints or other inkjet copies. Sorry, no photography or computer art.

ELGIBILITY: SAA Members in good standing. Membership dues for 2022 may be paid at the time of entry.

RULES OF ENTRY:

1. Maximum number of entries: Each member may submit 2 artworks plus one alternate (3 total). The alternate will be displayed if space allows.
2. Maximum size of entries: All wall-hung entries must fit within a space 30" wide x 84" (7 feet) high, including frames. If a third piece is submitted, all 3 must fit within this rectangle
3. 2-D art must be dry, properly framed, and ready to hang. **WIRE HANGERS ONLY.**
4. Art must be original (i.e., no reproductions), completed by the artist within the past three years, and not previously shown at the SAA Annual Show.
5. Art may not be removed prior to the scheduled pick-up date of November 6, 2022. Art not picked up by 6:00 p.m. on that date may be charged a storage fee of \$5.00 per day.
6. **Late entry forms and late art will not be accepted.**
7. SAA will have full authority over positioning and display.
8. SAA reserves the right to refuse any entry.
9. Artists agree to allow SAA to photograph any entries and use those photographs for show publicity.
10. Artists are encouraged to provide a biography and business cards to facilitate the sale of their art. Artists who sell work at the show will contribute 40% of the selling price to the Siskiyou Arts Museum, (this is their standard commission.)
11. SAA will take utmost care in handling the art but assumes no liability for loss or damage.
