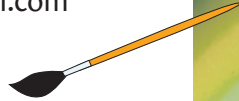

- Travel Light: Pack only what you need. Do you really need more than two brushes? Some artists will carry a bucket containing all their supplies—and then use the bucket as their chair!

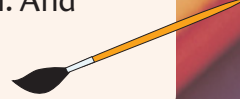
Simplify Your Palette: Choose colors that reflect where you will be painting. Keep it basic— try using: Burnt Umber, Cad. Yellow, Phthalo Green, Windsor Blue, Titanium White.

- Use local water when possible for watercolor. Creeks, lakes, etc. *but take care not to contaminate the water*
- Take a photo as a visual reference. • Sunglasses can alter your perception of colors. Always bring a hat.
